

## Southside Community Council Communications Group report January 2016

1. Community Day planning – I have contacted the South Central Neighbourhood office about the use of St Patrick Square, and received the following reply “I understand there are issues with regard to such events being held in both St Patrick and Nicolson Squares but am looking into this and will get back to you.” So no date has yet been set.
2. Notices advertising the Community Council meetings have been put up in noticeboards on the Meadows, St Patrick’s Square, The South Side Centre, Tesco Nicolson St, Nelson Hall, Co-op store, South Clerk Street, and Newington Library.
3. We have begun to think about leaflets for community engagement, particularly with the Community Day in mind.
4. Logo design – I have been in communication with Ian Sharman of Edinburgh College of Art, so we should have some designs to look at on 1<sup>st</sup> February.
5. Website – David Wood has agreed to write some text for the home page. We now have a link to our Facebook page.
6. Community postcards. We have been invited by the Southside Association to join them in producing a postcard celebrating the Gifford Park Mural. The University of Edinburgh are funding the printing of the postcards. All we have to do is provide some wording – basic information about the Community Council – and then we can use them to distribute as we wish.
